CHALLENGE PROGRAM (BATCH SUBSTANCES)

Applicable legislations:

Legislated under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act., Section 71 Notice published in the *Canada Gazette*.

The Challenge program is a federal government initiative to identify, develop and implement measures to assess and manage the risks posed by certain substances to the health of Canadians and their environment.

Companies that are required to report and choose not to, or knowingly report false information, will be prosecuted as outlined under Section 71 of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act.

Presently, there are 193 substances identified under the challenge (the Challenge substances) as priority for action. These substances have been divided into “batches”. So far, there have been 11 batches completed and more will come in the future.

Reporting Thresholds:

Any facility that meets or exceeds the reporting criteria is required to provide the information specified in the “Notice of release of technical information relevant to substances identified in the Challenge”.
