

HAZARDOUS WASTE INFORMATION NETWORK & TRAINING

Applicable legislation:

- Environmental Protection Act
- O.Reg. 347 General Waste Management)

The Hazardous Waste Information Network (HWIN) is a program that allows generators, carriers, and receivers of hazardous waste to inform the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) about their activities online. HWIN is a large part of the MOECC's hazardous waste management plan. This program requires generators (users) to renew annually, ensuring the safe handling of hazardous materials.

This program includes:

- The quality of hazardous waste information; and
- The accessibility of hazardous waste information.

It is important to note that when removing underground storage tanks (USTs), HWIN generator and waste class registration are required.
